

Researchers discover gene linked to Eosinophilic esophagitis

In a collaborative effort, researchers in Cincinnati and Philadelphia have identified a gene responsible for eosinophilic esophagitis. The Gene TSLP is linked to allergic inflammatory diseases. The study appears in Nature Genetics March 7th,. Look for a review in the next APFED newsletter.
